

New LP Recordings Now At Library

The Rye Free Reading Room has recently acquired eight new LP recordings, including works by Griffes, Rachmaninoff, Grieg, MacDowell, Bach, Brahms, Gottschalk and Horn.

Charles T. Griffes' best known work "The Roman Sketches" is played by the pianist Leonid Hambro who is with the New York Philharmonic. Griffes was at one time instructor, pianist and organist at the Hackely School in Tarrytown and it was there that he wrote the "Roman Sketches", which the Library has acquired.

Rachmaninoff's Piano Concerto No. 3 in D minor is played by Hor-

owitz and the London Symphony Orchestra.

Two albums of Grieg's "Lyric Pieces" are played by the pianist Walter Gieseking of whom the Saturday Review said he was "The greatest colorist of all . . . and this magnificent recording, which remains as one of the most impressive documents of contemporary pianism, will permit us to hear him again and again."

"Woodland Sketches" and "Sonata Tragica in G minor" by Edward MacDowell are played by Vivian Rivkin, pianist. The "Woodland Sketches" includes the familiar favorite "To a wild rose".

Bach's "Six Sonatas for Violin & Harpsichord" as played by Erick Friedman, violin, and Bruce Prince—Joseph, harpsichord, is a recording well worth hearing.

Brahms' "Three Piano Quartets" and Schuman's "Piano Quintet" are played by Arthur Rubinstein with the Guarneri Quartet. Alan Rich, music critic of the New York Magazine says that "the four works recorded here comprise the crown of the romantic chamber literature for strings and piano."

"The Piano Music of Louis Moreau Gottschalk" played by Amiram Rigai has universal appeal. This American composer of a hundred years ago takes the elements of Creole, Negro and French backgrounds that he found in his native New Orleans and blends them with European Romanticism into a fresh and vigorous example of the early American genre.

Paul Horn, a young flutist, took his instrument with him when he went to visit the Taj Mahal in India and there in a chamber whose acoustics were extraordinary he played and taped this strange and eerie music.
