1. A Marine Corps Reserve Officer Disposition Board, convened in accordance with the authority contained in reference (a), recently met at this Headquarters to make recommendations for retention in or discharge from the Marine Corps Reserve of those reserve officers who have been on the Inactive Status List for three years or more. Your name was among those considered by the board.

2. The Marine Corps is permitted to maintain on its rolls only those reserve officers who are required to fill mobilization needs and have been able to maintain their proficiency through participation in the Reserve. A determination as to which officers should be retained has been made by the Disposition Board and is based upon detailed mobilization requirements and the official records of this Headquarters.

3. It is regretted that it is necessary to inform you that your name was not among those recommended by the Board for retention. As a consequence, it is necessary that you be separated from the Marine Corps Reserve. Accordingly, pursuant to reference (b), you are hereby honorably discharged from the U. S. Marine Corps Reserve effective this date. A certificate of discharge which reflects your honorable service in the Marine Corps Reserve is enclosed herewith.

4. The Commandant of the Marine Corps takes this occasion to express his sincere appreciation for your past service and trusts that you will continue to maintain your interest in Marine Corps affairs.
